ALCOHOL-RELATED CANCER IN IOWA AND POLICY IDEAS TO REDUCE IT

Mary Charlton is a Professor of Epidemiology at the University of Iowa College of Public Health and the Director and Principal Investigator at the Iowa Cancer Registry. During her tenure, she has conducted numerous studies of risk factors and outcomes related to cancer. Dr. Charlton is involved in the development of the annual Cancer in Iowa document to report on the estimated number of new cancer cases and cancer deaths in Iowa, and to educate Iowans about the trends and public health issues related to cancer prevention, diagnosis and treatment. She was the co-author of the 2024 Cancer in Iowa Report highlighting Alcohol-Related Cancers.



Dr. Richard Deming will also be a part of the discussion. Stories may be shared of survivors of alcohol-related cancer.

Iowa has the 4th highest incidence of alcohol-related cancers in the U.S., and the highest rate in the Midwest.
